THE HEALING MINISTRY IN “THE FIELD HOSPITAL OF THE CHURCH” 24 – 28 July 2017 Fr. Jim McManus C.Ss.R.

A help to all those involved in ministry in their parishes or prayer groups, in care of the sick and elderly, or who have a special interest in the healing ministry.

When Pope Francis speaks about our pastoral ministry he reminds us that the Church is like a “field hospital after battle” and that the first duty of ministers, clerical or lay, is “to heal the wounds”.

Fr. Jim McManus will teach this pastoral course on the Healing Ministry in St. Mary's. Fr. Jim has been lecturing on the Healing Ministry for the past thirty years and has published several well received books including *The Healing Power of the Sacraments*, *Healing in the Spirit* and, just published, *Spiritual First Aid: Healing through the Sacraments*

Priests and lay ministers, especially those who bring Holy Communion to the sick and the house bound, will be encouraged as they reflect, during this week, on how the Church in our time is placing such an emphasis on the healing dimension of their pastoral ministry.
