STATIONS OF THE CROSS – take place on Fridays at 7pm. Sr Annette will be leading the Stations this week – if you would like to lead them next week then please speak to Father Gargaro.

LENTEN TALKS -our series of Lenten Talks is off this week but returns next week.

FORTY HOURS– takes place here in St Patrick's from Sunday 11th to Tuesday 13th March. On Monday 12th we have a Holy Hour and Benediction led by Br Darren Maslen SSS, a deacon preparing to be ordained a priest for the Blessed Sacrament Fathers; on Tuesday 13th we have a Holy Hour and Benediction led by Msgr Peter Magee, head of the Scottish Catholic Tribunal. Both services take place at 7pm. There is a sheet at the back of the church for volunteers to spend time with Our Lord – please make sure that every slot has at least two people, for the security of those attending and, most importantly, so that Our Lord is not left unattended. He wants us to bring our prayers, our needs, our sorrows and joys to Him – do not allow this opportunity to go to waste. How can we expect to spend Eternity with Him in heaven if we cannot give Him a few minutes here on earth?




