Holyday of Obligation – Wednesday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Our Lady into heaven, and it is a Holyday of Obligation, which means that all Catholics are obliged to attend Mass that day, just as on a Sunday. Here in the parish there will be a Vigil Mass at 6pm on Tuesday evening, and Masses on the day at 10am and 12.30pm. Since Wednesday is also the first day of school the primary school will be unable to join us for the 10am Mass as they normally would – instead there will be a Mass in school in the afternoon.



Carfin Pilgrimage – Sunday 2nd September. we need to know by today if you wish to go on the pilgrimage so that we can book transport. So far very few people have signed up and it may prove not be viable to hire a bus. Tickets are on sale this weekend for just £5- see Luisa/Rosaleen at the back of the church.

Gift Aid – we recently received another £2000 from the tax man thanks to your donations to the parish. If you pay tax and do not currently use Gift Aid then please talk to Luisa or Canon Gargaro about doing so.

Safeguarding Training – all volunteers who work with children or vulnerable adults (e.g. children's liturgy, SVDP, taking Communion to the sick) must have undertaken training by 31st October this year or they will no longer be allowed to volunteer (even if you have received similar training at work or for other voluntary activities). Some of our volunteers still need to complete this training, so if you are involved in these areas of parish life please speak to Canon Gargaro after Mass – he has a list of forthcoming training opportunities.
