PRISONERS' WEEK 20-27 November 2016

Pope Francis engaged with 1000 prisoners this week as part of the Year of Mercy. During Mass, Pope Francis explained to prisoners the need for hope:

“Whenever someone makes a mistake, the Father’s mercy is all the more present, awakening repentance, forgiveness, reconciliation, and peace.”

We will remember prisoners in our prayers during Prisoners' Week. In addition we are sending a cheque for £200 to support the work of the Barlinnie Chaplaincy Fund. While prisoners have their meals provided, everything else, such as toiletries and stamps, they have to pay for, largely through money sent in by their families. Unfortunately, due to poverty, many of these families find it impossible to support family members in prison. In addition, there has been an increase in the number of foreign prisoners who have no family connections in this country and this fund is often their only means of support. Fr Paul McAlinden, Fr John Gannon, Fr John Lyons and Fr Pat Boyle are all involved in this ministry and are our ambassadors of mercy to these prisoners.

PARISH FUNDRAISING

Funds raised are split 50/50 between the Parish and the Mission Project in Nigeria.

To date we have raised around £2000 for the Mission Project and £1500 for the Parish (we had some specific donations to the Mission Project). We will update the totals next week so that Fr Francis can prepare to take the money away with him after Christmas.
