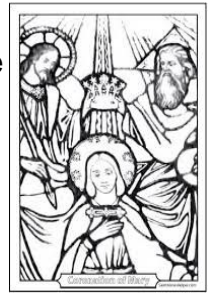
LIVING THEOLOGY COURSE; 26 TO 28 MAY 2017
