OCTOBER DEVOTIONS are on today at 5pm. Pope Francis has asked all Catholics to **pray the rosary each day in October** and to end the Rosary with the “Sub Tuum Praesidium” prayer and the prayer to St Michael the Archangel. These are printed for you on a pink or blue prayer sheet available at the back of the church. Please make an effort to join in the Holy Father’s request for prayer.

Parish Costs – every October we get the two biggest bills of the year – the insurance premium and our contribution to Archdiocesan and national funds (“the levy”). The levy this year is £4100 and the insurance premium is £8000. Thankfully we have the money in the bank to pay these but it is useful to have some idea of the unavoidable costs that we face as a parish. It takes all our Sunday collections for six months just to pay these two bills!



The Sacrament of Confirmation for the P7 children will take place in St Mungo’s, Townhead, on Wednesday 7th November at 7pm. To help get ready for the celebration there will be parish preparation sessions after 10am Mass for parents and pupils on Sundays 21st October, 28th October, and 4th November, which all those preparing for the sacrament (and their parents) should attend. Today there is a ceremony of enrolment, where the children will make a public commitment to prepare properly to receive Confirmation.

Holydays of Obligation – the bishops have recently made some changes to Holydays of Obligation. The changes are relatively minor – from next year when St Peter & Paul (29th June) or the Assumption (15th August) fall on a Monday or a Saturday the feast will be moved to the Sunday; when All Saints (1st November) falls on a Saturday it will be moved to the Sunday but it won't be moved if it falls on a Monday. Don't worry though – you don't need to memorise these details, just keep watching the bulletin and our Facebook page and we will keep you right (we hope!).

Net Ministries – Net Ministries are an international youth evangelisation organisation, approved by the bishops of Scotland, who will be working in St Thomas Aquinas for two weeks in November. The school is looking for families willing to host some of the young missionaries – are you willing and able to do so? You need to take at least two, provide them with somewhere to sleep (bed, couch, sleeping bag), and provide breakfast, a packed lunch, and dinner.
