ADVENT IN THE PARISH AND DIOCESE

During Advent we will sing Acclamation 2 on the sheet.

Primary School Carol Concert – takes place on Monday at 10am. All parishioners are welcome, and we will go across after 9.30am Mass. This means that there will be no Divine Mercy devotions this week.

Advent Confessions – it is important to get to Confession before Christmas so that we can celebrate it in the right spirit. We are lucky in that there are numerous opportunities to get to Confession on our doorstep. Every day there are Confessions in St Aloysius (Weekdays 1130-1215 & 1715-1740; Saturdays 1030-1215, 1400-1515, & 1615-1730; Sunday 2015-2045), in the Cathedral (Weekdays 0745-0755; 1230-1300, & 1645-1710; Saturdays 0745-0755, 1200-1300, & 1600-1710), and at St Mungo's (Weekdays 1030-1200 & 1630-1730; Saturdays 1030-1200 & 1630-1800. There are also Confessions here in the parish Saturdays 1730-1750 and Sundays 9.30-9.50, and after any Mass on request. For Advent there are also two local special events:

(1) Day of Confessions in Cathedral on Thursday 20th December from 0745 to 1745 and

(2) the Deanery Reconciliation service in St Aloysius on Saturday 22nd December from 11am to 12 noon.

Few, if any, of us could say that we couldn't get to one of these times in one of these local churches – so please make the effort to prepare properly for Christmas.

St Nicholas Care fund / Pastoral Care Trust Boxes – for Advent are available at the back of the church. Please take one away with you and collect your loose change over Advent for this good cause. There is also a special collection today in support of the Fund.

"Catholicism" by Bishop Robert Barron – continues in the church house this Sunday evening at 6pm. Don't worry if you missed the previous episodes you can still come along and enjoy the others.
