## PARISH FUNDRAISING

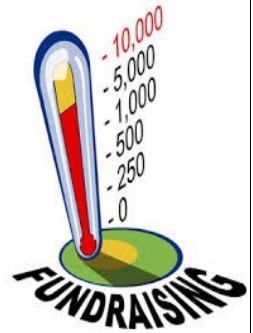
Our homebaking stall raised £30.60 last Sunday. We also received a donation of £30 for the Mission Project in Nigeria. Many thanks!
