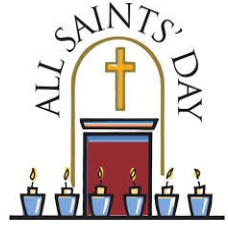

\*a box will be situated at the back of the church on a permanent basis asking for coins or notes left over from holidays-foreign or otherwise!

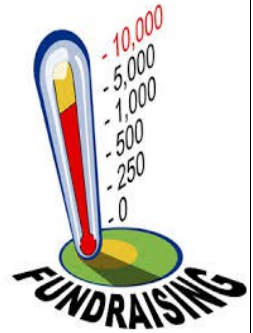
\*a sing along concert to be held in the church on Sunday the 13th of December- details to follow
