**Mission Sunday** – today we celebrate World Mission Sunday, when we pray for the spread of the Gospel throughout the world. Many people today think that “mission” is unimportant, that it doesn’t matter what people believe, or even that evangelising is wrong, and that it’s OK to have any religion or none. Today, and this Extraordinary Mission Month, reminds us of Our Lord’s parting command to His followers: “Go, teach all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19). This applies still to us today: we must teach all nations, beginning in our own nation, teaching them that God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, exists and loves them, and calls them to worship Him in His holy Catholic Church. Please be generous in supporting the second collection for Missio Scotland, but more importantly please be generous in sharing your faith with your friends and family.



**NOVEMBER LISTS** – every November we pray for all the faithful departed. The custom is that we list those for whom we want to pray and Mass is offered for all these people throughout November.
