**Sunday of the Word of God:** Pope Francis has asked us to reflect on the gift of Scripture on the third Sunday in Ordinary Time each year, so please do take the chance to give time each day to reading the Bible or perhaps listening to the "Bible in a Year" podcast with Fr Mike Schmitz. At the end of 2024 we expect to move to a new translation of the Bible in our readings at Mass, so that will be a further opportunity for reflection on the Scriptures in our lives.

Youth: we had a meeting on Sunday to plan for our youth work in the year ahead — Tamara will keep on working in the school, our parish teams will keep on with children's liturgy and pre-sacramental catechesis, and we will develop further our joint youth group with St Peter's (more about that below). We should be very grateful for the work that our youth team do but all of us also need to get involved: firstly, by praying for the young people and the helpers; secondly, if you have children or grandchildren, by encouraging them to come along to our activities; and thirdly, by talking to other parents and grandparents about what is going on and encouraging them to get their families involved. Our Faith is a wonderful treasure and we should want to pass it on to the next generations in every way that we can.
