SAFEGUARDING IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

On 24th November 2013, the Bishops' Conference of Scotland announced that it had commissioned an independent review into the suitability and robustness of the Safeguarding procedures and protocols of the Catholic Church in Scotland.

The Very Reverend Dr. Andrew McLellan, a former Moderator of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland, was invited by the Bishops to lead the review.

Dr. McLellan has now published his Commission's Report - a detailed and substantial document, the product of almost two years' endeavour by many able and committed people. It gives the Catholic Church in Scotland a vision and a programme to strengthen the work of Safeguarding and respond to the needs of survivors. Information on the findings of the Commission and how the Church will now respond has been summarised in a leaflet- **please pick up a leaflet at the back of the church.** The first action- a public apology- took place this week.
