FORTHCOMING COLLECTIONS: Next Sunday, 3rd June, there will be a Day for Life collection. This is a day dedicated to raising awareness about the value and meaning of every human life at every stage and in every condition. This year we are highlighting **human trafficking and modern slavery**.

WE HAVE A NEW CANON! The Archbishop has decided to appoint a number of new Honorary Canons to the Cathedral Chapter, one of whom is our own parish priest Fr Paul Gargaro. They will be installed in the Cathedral on Friday 8th June, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, at Mass at 7pm, to which all parishioners are warmly invited.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION – are invited to a meeting in the Church on Tuesday at 7pm. Next Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi and it's good for those whose ministry in the parish is so closely linked to the Body & Blood of Christ to prepare with some prayer together and with a refresher on the details of this ministry. Please come along if you can.

WALSINGHAM PILGRIMAGE – Eddie and Rosaleen are proposing to organise a pilgrimage to Walsingham and would like to know what interest there is in attending. The proposal is a 4 day/ 3 night pilgrimage by bus starting Monday 17th September. Accommodation will be Half Board at the Holiday Inn Norwich and the price will be approximately £250 depending on numbers (single room supplement £60). MAY DEVOTIONS – take place every Sunday during May at 5pm. Every day during May the Rosary is said at the Lady Altar and on the altar there is a box of petitions – if you want to commend your own special intentions to the prayers of the parish then you can do so by writing them down on the sheets provided next to the Lady Altar and placing them in the Petitions Box. Feel free too to come frequently to the church for private prayer during the day asking for Our Lady's prayers during her special month.



GDPR – You will have seen a lot of the TV or online about GDPR, the new data protection regulations. These will affect the way that we gather and retain information about you. Mostly this will involve

Baptisms or Funerals: getting you to sign a consent form whenever we are asking you for personal details

Weddings: there will be some more complications if you are looking for a copy of your baptism certificate (e.g. before getting married): you will now need to provide photographic ID and collect the certificates personally – you can't ask a relative to do it for you.

Social Media: There are also occasions – e.g. First Communions, parish celebrations, etc. - when we take photographs to be used on the parish social media. If you wish not to be included in any photos please tell the photographers or Father Gargaro.

It is also worth noting in terms of data protection that both the inside and outside of the church is covered by **CCTV** which we use to prevent and detect crime and similar problems.

In the near future we will also change our parish **email address** to help with data security – please keep an eye out for the change, since after that the old address will no longer be monitored.

ST MARGARET'S PILGRIMAGE – you are invited to join in a pilgrimage in honour of St Margaret, Secondary Patron of Scotland, on Sunday 3rd June. Guided tours of the sites in Dunfermline associated with St Margaret begin at 11am, the Procession begins at 1.45pm, and Mass is at 3pm.

IRELAND – unfortunately, as you will know by now, Ireland voted decisively against the protection of the most vulnerable. Nonetheless our prayers were not wasted and must not cease now. We should not see the large “yes” majority as a measure of defeat but rather as a measure of the challenge ahead of us, the same challenge Our Lord gives His apostles in today's Gospel: “Go, therefore, make disciples of all nations”. Our Lord is always with us!
