MASS FOR THE SICK TODAY, SUNDAY 30TH AUGUST

We will be celebrating the Sacrament of the Sick during the 10am Mass today.

If you wish to receive the Sacrament of the Sick please come to the front few rows on either side of the church.



"The special grace of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick has as its effects: the uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church; the **strengthening, peace, and courage** to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age; the **forgiveness of sins**, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance; the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his soul; the preparation for passing over to eternal life" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1532).

Does a person have to be dying to receive this sacrament? **No.** The Catechism says, "The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived" (CCC 1514).

PRAYER FOR A SICK PERSON

Dear Jesus, Divine Physician and Healer of the sick, I turn to you in this time of illness. O dearest comforter of the troubled, alleviate my worry and sorrow with your gentle love, and grant me the grace and strength to accept this burden. Dear God, I place my worries in your hands. I place myself under your care and humbly ask that you restore your servant to health again. Above all, grant me the grace to acknowledge your will and know that whatever you do, you do for the love of me. Amen.
