St Patrick's statue in the primary school – many of you will remember the statue of St Patrick that is found at the front door of our primary school and which, it seems, was originally located in the boys' school. Unfortunately, as the years have passed it has become more and more damaged and is now in a poor state (pictures on facebook/website). To celebrate the centenary of Catholic education this year, it has been decided to restore the statue in memory of all the former staff and pupils of our primary school. So that the parish can participate in this there will be a special collection on 2nd December 2018. Please be generous in supporting this project, which will celebrate the 1918 Education Act, commemorate the former staff and pupils, and dedicate the future of the school under the guidance of St Patrick.

Catholic Education Sunday – will take place on Sunday 18th November when we will be joined by representatives of St Thomas Aquinas high school and when we will have a second collection in support of the work of Catholic Education.

Lists and donation envelopes are available at the back of the church. Please return them to Fr Gargaro or to the box at the back.

Pieta Altar – during November all the November Lists and the Parish Book of the Dead are placed at the Pieta Altar, under the beautiful image of Our Lady holding her dead Son, asking that she can hold all our beloved dead in her prayers too.
