The widow of Nain

Strangely the dead young man that Jesus brings back to life in today's Gospel is perhaps not the main focus. Rather, the man's mother, a widow burying her only son, is the central figure. In a patriarchal society, she is powerless and helpless without a male family member to provide for her and to speak for her. Significantly Luke says that Jesus gave the young man to his mother. In doing so, he brought her back to life too!
