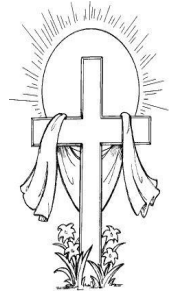

HOLIDAY OF OBLIGATION – Thursday in the **Solemnity of the Ascension** and a Holyday of Obligation, which means that we must attend Mass that day. Masses here in the parish are at 6pm on Wednesday evening and 10am and 12.30pm on Thursday. The primary school will join us at 10am.

MAY DEVOTIONS – take place every Sunday during May at 5pm. Every day during May the Rosary is said at the Lady Altar and on the altar there is a box of petitions – if you want to commend your own special intentions to the prayers of the parish then you can do so by writing them down on the sheets provided next to the Lady Altar and placing them in the Petitions Box. Feel free too to come frequently to the church for private prayer during the day asking for Our Lady's prayers during her special month.
