During Advent we will sing Acclamation 2 on the sheet.

This week in the parish – Canon Gargaro is away to Rome for a few days this week on Tribunal business and so on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday there will be morning prayers instead of Mass. On Friday Mass will be at 7pm rather than 9.30am.
