### **ANNIVERSARY MASS FOR VICTIMS OF THE ANDORRA STAR**

On Monday July 2, the 1pm Mass in St Andrew's Cathedral, 196 Clyde Street, Glasgow will mark the anniversary of the sinking of the Arandora Star, which was torpedoed on that day in 1940 leading to the loss of more than 800 lives.

The victims from Scotland are commemorated in the Italian Garden next to the Cathedral where the 200 year old olive tree gifted by the people of Tuscany symbolises peace and reconciliation.

## **CANON GARGARO TAKES ON ANOTHER JOB!**

The Bishops' Conference of Scotland has announced the appointment of Canon Paul Gargaro as the new Judicial Vicar of the Scottish Catholic Interdiocesan Tribunal (SCID) with effect from 1st August 2018. Canon Paul Gargaro will continue to be Parish Priest at St Patrick's, Anderston, and Vice-Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Glasgow.

The Bishops have also advised that the premises of the Tribunal will move from the south side of Glasgow to the Curial Offices of the Archdiocese of Glasgow at 196 Clyde Street.
