Parish Safeguarding Audit: has now been submitted. Along with our other safeguarding efforts, hopefully this helps keep our parish a safe place for children and vulnerable adults. If you have any concerns you can speak to them, or to the Archdiocesan Safeguarding Office, or go straight to the police or social work.

Pilgrimage to Carfin: to mark the month of May we have booked a bus for a pilgrimage to Carfin for the evening of Friday 31st May. The rosary at Carfin is at 8pm, so we intend to leave here at 6.45pm so as to have some time to see around the shrine beforehand. This will be a joint trip with St Peter's Partick, and if you are interested, please put your name on the sheet at the back of the church. The bus will cost £5 per person, payable now at the stall. We should be back here by 9.30pm.

Sunday Missals: in autumn we will start using a new translation of the Bible at Mass throughout Scotland, England, and Wales. We will talk more about this as the time approaches, but for just now we can pre-order Sunday Missals for a slight discount.
