

Pilgrimage to Carfin: to mark the month of May we have booked a bus for a pilgrimage to Carfin for the evening of Friday 31st May. The rosary at Carfin is at 8pm, so we intend to leave here at 6.45pm. This will be a joint trip with St Peter's Partick, and if you are interested, please put your name on the sheet at the back of the church. The bus will cost £5 per person, payable now at the stall. We should be back here by 9.30pm.

Sunday Missals: in autumn we will start using a new translation of the Bible at Mass throughout Scotland, England, and Wales. We will talk more about this as the time approaches, but for just now we can pre-order Sunday Missals for a slight discount.
